Alberta Louise Clark of Prescott Road Zolfo Springs Fl. passed into heaven Monday, March 18, 2024.

Alberta was born December 13, 1934, in Westfield, New York to Robert Earl and Irene Dorman and a family of three brothers and a sister. With the death of her father in 1940, at the age of five the family was split and placed in the foster care system. She was eventually taken in by Earl and Clair Nickerson and their three boys from Clymer, New York. She was raised and loved by the Nickersons as their own. She attended Clymer schools and then moved with them to Wauchula Florida in 1952 as they relocated their Dairy Farm.

In 1954 she married Paul Clark of Corry, Pennsylvania. They moved with Paul's work and finally put down roots in Spartansburg, Pennsylvania, and raised two sons.

She was reunited after 30 years with her three brothers Raymond, William, and Lavern Dorman, and her sister Mary (Dorman) Lennard. After a short stay in California, in the mid 1980s Alberta returned to Wauchula in the 1990s and lived on the family farm taking care of her Mother Clair, and then her son Michael who suffered from M.S. Alberta loved antiques. She also was an avid painter. She loved to spend time with the Hardee County young people teaching crafts and painting.

She is preceded in death by her parents, Clair and Earl Nickerson, her son Micheal Ray Clark, her brothers Norman Nickerson, Roger Nickerson, and

daughter-in-law Jennifer Clark.

Alberta is survived by her son Daniel (Susan) Clark of Stone Mountain Ga. and her brother Howard (Debbie) Nickerson of Luraville, Florida, her sister Mary (Dorman) Lennard of California, four grandchildren Brandy (Josh) Howell, of Stone Mountain, Ga., Kristin (Ben) Stuart of Roswell, Ga., Grant (Brittney) Clark of Tucker, Ga., and Andrew Clark of Los Angeles, California. Along with four great-grandchildren. Andrew, Henry, Morgan, and Everette.
