Angela M. Davis, 75, of Arcadia, passed away on December 10, 2012 at Young At Heart Adult Care Center in Punta Gorda. She was born in Kennebunk, Maine on December 21, 1936. She had been a resident of Arcadia since June 2010, moving from Key Largo where she had lived for 58 years.

Angela was a teacher and guidance counselor with the Key Largo School District, retiring after 38 years, and also with the Florida Keys Electric Co-Op for 12 years. She loved her children and grandchildren, school kids, and books. An article was written in the paper about her being one of her school kids mentors. Angela participated in charities at school, walk-a-thons, and fundraisers. She was a very involved member in her church, First Baptist Church of Key Largo. Angela was a lung/thyroid cancer survivor.
