January 23, 1937 - August 17, 2017

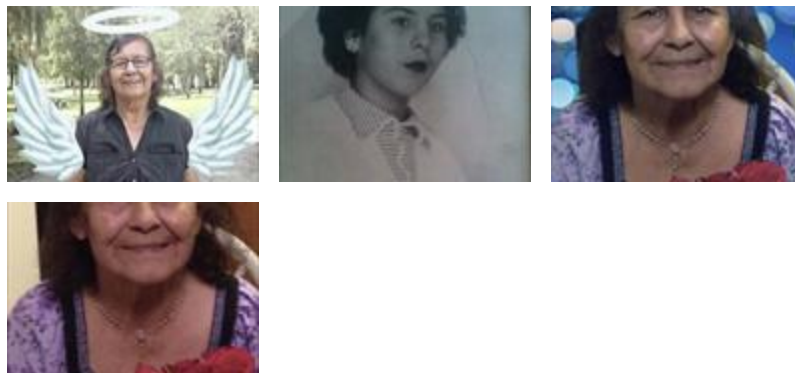

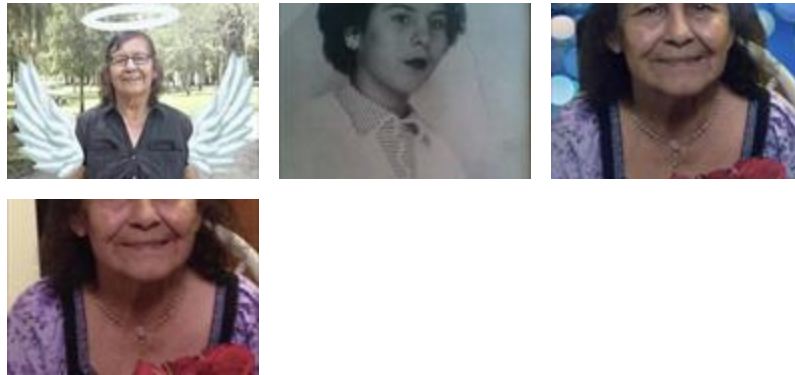
