Dewey D. Carroll, 97, of Wauchula, passed away on Saturday, September 28, 2013 at Resthaven. Dewey was born in Nauvoo, Alabama on May 25, 1916 and had been a Hardee County resident for 65 years. He was a member of Northside Baptist Church. Dewey had retired from Hardee County, where he was a grader operator, and from the public works department of the City of Wauchula.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Genola Carroll; four brothers, Otis, Theodore, Olin, and Millard Carroll; two sisters, Irene Chambless and Agnes Carroll; and one grandson, Kenneth Thomas.
