Reverend Herman Boyette, 94, of Bowling Green, passed away at Resthaven assisted living facility on Friday, May 29th 2015. He was born in Hardee County, Florida on May 11th 1921. Reverend Boyette was a U.S. Army World War II Veteran and was the youngest of ten siblings.
