James Floyd Murray, 91, of Bowling Green, passed away peacefully on March 18, 2013 at the Good Shepherd Hospice House in Sebring. He was born on November 13, 1921 in Egan, Tennessee, to parents Henry Waterson and Emma Sharp Murray. He was a World War II Veteran and proudly served his Country in the U. S. Army, where he received an Honorary Certificate of Commendation from Brigadier General E. J. McGaw. He moved to Bowling Green, FL with his parents, four sisters, and brother in the summer of 1939, at age 14. There he met the "love of his life", his next door neighbor, Inez P. Terrell, who later, in 1943, became his wife of almost 70 years. He worked as a carpenter and farmer and was employed by Nicholson Supply as a salesman and shop foreman, retiring in 2002.
