Rev. Jimmy Morse, 63, of Bowling Green, passed away on August 17, 2015 at Somers Hospice House in Sebring. He was born in Moultrie, Georgia on December 2, 1951 and came to Hardee County from Tampa in October 1993. Jimmy was the founder and pastor and a member of Celebration Fellowship. He had been the pastor at Northside Baptist Church and four other churches.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Allan and Rhoda Morse, and a sister, Laquetta Marie Morse.
