Julie Ann England Bridges, 42, of Zolfo Springs, Florida, passed away on Sunday, September 10, 2017. Julie was born in Sarasota, Florida on January 30, 1975 and had been a resident of Hardee County since 2003. She came here from North Port, Florida. Julie began her career in law enforcement as dispatcher/communications officer at the Venice Police Department. She had been employed at the Hardee County Sheriff Office for 13 years, and was a sheriff's deputy.

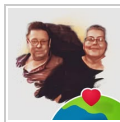
