December 3, 1944 - March 9, 2024

Larry Bruce Paulson, 79, of Baxter, MN, and Zolfo Springs, FL passed away unexpectedly and went to be with his Lord and Savior on March 9, 2024, with his wife and friends by his side. Services will be held at Oak Grove Baptist Church, Wauchula, FL on Monday, March 18, 2024, at 2:00 pm with visitation one hour before the service. A Celebration of Life will be held in Baxter, MN in the summer of 2024.

Larry was born to Melvin and Bernice (Halvorson) Paulson in Brainerd, MN on December 3, 1944, and lived in Anoka, Aldrich, and Verndale, MN until the family moved back to Brainerd where he attended Brainerd Public Schools for Grades 4 – 12.

He joined the National Guard and Army in 1965 and worked for the City of Brainerd for 32 years. He was also a volunteer hospital and law enforcement chaplain. Larry was formerly married and blessed with two children: Heather & Matt. He and Hope (Ludeman) Lindberg were married on March 22, 1991 in Brainerd. In retirement, Larry and Hope loved spending their winters in Zolfo Springs, FL. Larry enjoyed family, reading his Bible, praying for people, going to coffee shops, music, hunting deer in MN and wild hogs in FL. Larry's Christian faith during his life was of utmost importance to him.
