



## Louise S. Cooper

November 5, 1917 - July 27, 2015

Louise Shirley Cooper, age 97, died at her home in Bowling Green on July 27, 2015. She was born into a large farming family in Daleville, Alabama on November 5, 1917. In 1933, her family moved to Bowling Green, where she married William Troy Cooper on July 8, 1935. From 1942, they lived in Tampa where Louise was active in the Northside Baptist Church. After Troy died in 1974, Louise worked at Maas Brothers department store (now Macy's) until she returned to her old family home in Bowling Green in 2000.
