Louise Durrance, 91, of Bowling Green, passed away on Sunday, August 23, 2015 at Resthaven. She was born on January 8, 1924 to Walter and Dora Bryan and was raised in the Torrey community. Her parents farmed and Louise grew up picking strawberries and growing vegetables, along with her twin sister Lucille, sister Helen, and brothers Jack and Lemuel.

After graduating from high school, she and Lucille worked at Carlstrom Airfield in Arcadia. Later she moved to Baltimore, Maryland and worked at the May Co. She also lived in Texas for a time before returning to Hardee County and marrying Doyle Durrance in 1950. They raised their family in the College Hill community, farming, growing citrus, and raising cattle.

Louise was a lifelong member of the Bowling Green First United Methodist Church and participated in all its activities and ministries. She loved her Sunday school class, and traveled to Hawaii, Alaska, California, and the North Carolina mountains with many of her classmates and friends.

God and family were priorities for Louise. She loved and served them both to the best of her abilities. She also cherished her Resthaven caregivers, roommates, and friends.

She was preceded in death by her husband Doyle Durrance and daughter,
