Miguel was the son of Hector and Stephanie Mier of Wauchula. He was the answer to their prayers, and they waited for his birth with faith, hope, and joyful expectation.

Miguel weighed 7 pounds 15 ounces and was 23 inches long.

Miguel's family was blessed with 17 days filled with faith, hope, and love.

Miguel was baptized and received the sacrament of anointing of the sick at the bedside by Father Miguel Gonzalez from St. James Catholic Cathedral in Orlando. 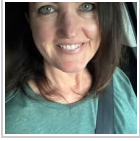
