Rev. Leonard Daniel (Dan) Mattson, age 68, passed away on November 15, 2011. He was a resident of Arcadia, FL for 10 years before moving to North Port. He was a social studies teacher, Lutheran Minister, social worker and counselor. As Head Chaplain at Lutheran Hospital in Ft.
