Richard R. Wiggins, 84, of Lakeland, passed away at Good Shepherd Hospice in Auburndale on May 12, 2012. He was born in Scranton, Arkansas on February 10, 1928. Mr. Wiggins had been a resident of Wauchula from January 1967 (when he and his wife Marjorie came from Missouri) to April 2006, at which time they moved to Polk County.
