Ronald L. McCoy, 82, of Wauchula, passed away on September 28, 2011 at his home. Ron was born in Saugas, California on May 7, 1929 and moved to Florida in 1966. He was a Baptist and a World War II veteran serving in the U. S. Army. Ron was employed in the NASA Shuttle Program as a shuttle manager with Boeing North American in Rockwell and California.
