Roscoe Lamar Hilliard, age 88, of Zolfo Springs, Florida passed away on Wednesday, August 10, 2016 in Sebring. He was born in Leigh High Acres, Florida, on September 28, 1927. Mr. Hilliard had been a Hardee County resident since 1990, coming from West Virginia; he previously lived in Dumfries, Virginia for many years.

Roscoe was a Baptist, and worked at Possum Point Power Station in Dumfries, VA, then for Mt. Storm Power Station in Mt. Storm, WV as the station manager.
