Mrs. Virginia Rutland nee Wilkerson died peacefully at home on Monday, December 4, 2017 in Wauchula, Florida at the age of 89.

Virginia is survived by her children, Janetta Kieffer, Roger Rutland and Bill Rutland; her sister Ruth Audrey Skaff in Jacksonville; and several nieces and nephews.


