Beloved Husband, Father, and Grandfather Walter Richard "Dickie" Wheeler, a man of Christian

faith was called home at the age of 73. Dickie was battling an aggressive form of cancer when he passed

away at his home in Wauchula, FL on the morning of Wednesday, February 22, 2023.

Dickie was born on April 5, 1949, and was a long-time resident of Arcadia. He attended Desoto

County High School where he met the love of his life, Belinda Claire Boyette. They married on the 29th of

June, 1969 in Homestead, FL. Together they raised 4 children and were the proud grandparents of 7.

After high school, Dickie Joined the U.S. Navy serving honorably for 4 years during the War in Vietnam.

He worked as a real estate agent in Arcadia before relocating to Miami to join the family business,

Boyette and Sons Land Development. Together they became prominent builders in Miami and Kendall

throughout the 1980s. He continued a career as a Civil Engineering Superintendent, specializing in road

construction throughout Miami-Dade and Broward County. In the early 2000s, he relocated to Wauchula

in anticipation of retirement and worked his final years as a State Correctional Officer, retiring in 2011.
