Weyman Randolph Darley, 81, of Ona, Florida passed away at his home on Tuesday, March 9, 2021. He was born in Camilla, Georgia on July 9, 1939, moving to Hardee County, Florida in 1946. Weyman was a member of New Zion Baptist Church and was an ordained minister, serving as supply pastor in Hardee, Polk, and Okeechobee Counties.
